**1. AGE LIMIT:** Minimum 18 Years and Maximum 22 Years as on **07.08.2019.**

**3. SELECTION METHOD:** The selection process will consist of test in 3 stages. (Stage 1 & 2 – Written Test and Stage 3 - Trade /Skill Test). There will be negative marking in the written Examination for incorrect answers.

**Stage 1- Preliminary Test** : Questions will be on Mathematics, Science and General Awareness.

**Stage 2- Advanced test** : Candidates clearing Preliminary Test will be eligible for appearing in Advanced Test (*Questions will be from the respective trade*).

**Stage 3- Trade /Skill Test:** Only for those candidates who have cleared the **Stage-2** test and will be on *go/no-go* basis.

**4. SCOPE OF TRAINING:** Selected candidates will be given training at NRB, Kalpakkam & NRB, Tarapur in various aspects of relevant trades, as per prescribed syllabi of each trade and for meeting stringent requirements of NRB, Kalpakkam & NRB, Tarapur.

**The candidates will not have any choice/option for any particular training programme/training place.**

**5. ABSORPTION AFTER SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF TRAINING:** Upon successful completion of training, trainees will be considered for absorption in the following grade at the time of appointment depending on their performance during the period of training and interview to be held at the end of the training.

2. Candidates empanelled under WAIT LIST will be offered appointment ONLY in case candidate from the MAIN LIST does not join.
3. The validity of operation of wait-list will be one year from the date of preparation of the Select Panel.
4. The candidates will be given a choice to answer the questions in written exam/trade test in English/Hindi.
5. Candidates are required to have a valid-e-mail ID and Mobile Number. It should be kept active during the entire currency of recruitment.
6. The nature of duties to be performed by the above categories involves working in round the clock shift duties, in operational plants and areas .
7. The eligibility criteria including the period of experience as prescribed in the advertisement will be determined with reference to the last date of receipt of applications (as applicable).
8. SC/ST outstation candidates called for written examination will be paid to and fro travelling allowance of second-class Railway fare by the shortest route (subject to production of tickets) as per rules. #### **APPLICATION FEE: ₹ 100**

- Fee is exempted for candidates belonging to SC/ST category, PWD candidates, Ex-servicemen and Women candidates.

The OBC candidates should also enclose self declaration of non-creamy layer status in the format as given in *\*Annexure-2*.
5. OBC for the purpose of AGE RELAXATION AND RESERVATION will mean "persons of OBC categories not belonging to the Creamy Layer" as defined in Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training OM No.36012/22/93-Estt.(SCT) dated 08.09.93, modified vide Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training OM No.36033/3/2004-Estt.(Res) dated 09.03.2004 and 14.10.2008, and latest modification vide Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training OM No.36033/1/2013-Estt.(Res) dated 27.05.2013 and latest modification vide Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training OM No. 36033/1/2013-Estt (Res.) dated 13/09/2017 (as per the format given in *\*Annexure-3*).
6. Disability Certificate from the appropriate authority regarding physical disability [as per the format given at *\*Annexure-4* (applicable to persons with disability)].
7. Proof of the effect that they have been affected by 1984 riots (as applicable).

8. Certificate regarding domiciled in Kashmir Division from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989 (if claiming age relaxation for Kashmir division).
9. **EWS (Economically Weaker Section) Reservation:** Candidates who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SC/ST/OBC and whose family gross annual income is below Rs.8 Lakh (Rupees eight lakh) are to be identified as EWS for benefit of reservation for EWS. The income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also candidates whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of family income:
- 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
  - Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
  - Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
  - Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.
- The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.
- The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.
- The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Income and Asset Certificate issued by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format as given in **Annexure \*** shall only be accepted as candidate's claim as belonging to EWS:
- District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluk Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner
  - Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate
  - Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and
  - Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.
- The candidates applying against the vacancies reserved for EWS must possess Income and Asset Certificate as on closing date of registration of application. Further, these candidates are also required to produce valid Income and Asset Certificate during document verification. In case of non-compliance to these stipulations, their claim for reserved status under EWS will not be entertained and the candidature / application of such candidates, if fulfilling all the eligibility conditions for General (UR) category, will be considered under General (UR) vacancies only.

**IMPORTANT REQUIREMENT FOR PHYSICAL DISABILITY CERTIFICATE**

- According to the persons with disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 1996 notified on 31.12.1996 by the Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and (2) of Section 73 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (1 of 1996)], a disability certificate shall be issued by a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or a State Government. The Central/State Government may constitute a Medical Board consisting of at least three members, out of which, at least, one member shall be a Specialist from the relevant field.
- The certificate would be valid for a period of 5 years for those whose disability is temporary. The Medical Board shall indicate the period of validity of the certificate where there are chances of variation in the degree of disability. For those who acquired permanent disability, the validity can be shown as permanent. On representation by the applicant, the Medical Board may review its decision having regard to all the facts and circumstances of the case and pass such orders in the matter as it thinks fit.
- Those SC/ST/OBC persons with disabilities selected on their own merit without relaxed standards along with other candidates will be considered against unreserved vacancies provided the post is identified for persons with disability of relevant category (as applicable).
