Specification of Stainless Steel Tubes and Rods

1.0 DESCRIPTION OF ITEMS:

- 1.1 **SS316L Seamless Tubes**, Size: Outer Diameter Φ 6.35 mm x 0.50 mm wall thickness.
Length of the tubes: At least 80% of the supplied tubes shall be of length 2.1 meter. Rest of the supplied tubes may be smaller length but not less than 1 meter.
Quantity: 500 meter.
- 1.2 **SS316L Rods**, Diameter Φ 6.5 mm.
Length of the rods: 1 to 2 meter each.
Quantity: 50 meter.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK:

- 2.1 Straightness of the tube and rod material shall be better than 1 mm along their full length.
- 2.2 Test certificate (from government approved laboratory) of the tube material shall be supplied along with the material at the time of delivery.
- 2.3 All material shall be properly packed in a wooden box to prevent damage during transportation and handling.

3.0 DELIVERY PERIOD:

- 3.1 Transportation: Item shall be delivered free of cost to AFD, BARC, Trombay, Mumbai – 400085 with prior intimation to the undersigned.
- 3.2 Delivery Period: Items shall be delivered within 15 days from the date of receipt of firm purchase order.
- 3.3 Any delay in completion of order, which is attributed to supplier, will be liable for penalty @ 0.5% per week (maximum 5%) to be imposed on supplier.

4.0 TERMS & CONDITIONS OF WORK:

- 4.1 There is no Free Issue Material (FIM).
- 4.2 The price should be quoted item wise.
- 4.3 Quotation must be printed on letter head and it must mention GST Number, PAN Number of the firm, etc.
- 4.4 The quotation must clearly mention the name of the signatory and should bear company seal.
- 4.5 The quotation must clearly mention the outer diameter & wall thickness of the tubes in mm and outer diameter of rods in mm.
- 4.6 Declaration to be submitted along with the offer:
The prospective supplier shall declare as to whether he has any relation working in BARC or himself is an ex-employee of BARC, or has an ex-employee of DAE on his pay rolls.
- 4.7 Income Tax @ 2% and surcharge @ 3% education cess on tax as applicable shall be deducted from your bill.
- 4.8 Payment shall be made after the receipt, acceptance of the Items and on receipt of the following documents:
- a. Delivery challan in duplicate.
 - b. Tax invoice in triplicate.
 - c. Advanced stamped receipt in favour of Accounts Officer, BARC, Trombay, Mumbai.
 - d. Electronic Clearing Service (ECS).
 - e. Original set of test certificates for each lot of material supplied.

4.9 Tax Invoice should be on letter head of the supplier and GST no. of the firm shall be mentioned on the tax invoice. Advance part payment or against delivery cannot be made.

5.0 CONFIDENTIALITY CONDITION:

No party shall disclose any information, to any third party concerning the matters under this contract generally. In particular, any information identified as "proprietary in nature by the disclosing party shall be kept strictly confidential by the receiving party and shall not be disclosed to any third party without the written consent of the original disclosing party. This clause shall apply to the sub-contractors, consultants, advisers or the employees engaged by the party with equal force.

Any contravention of the above mentioned provisions by contractor, sub-contractors, consultants, advisers or the employees engaged by the contractor will invite penal consequences under the legislation of restricted information categories under section 18 of the Atomic Energy Act 1962 and official secrets act 1923.

The contractor or sub- contractor, consultant, adviser or the employees engaged by the contractor shall not use BARC'S name for any publicity through any public media like press, radio, TV or internet without prior written approval of BARC.
