

- 1.0 Medical Section, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Mysuru is providing health care facility under Contributory Health Service Scheme (CHSS) to DAE employees and their families. BARC Mysuru desires to empanel chemist/s having experience in supply of medicines to Government/Semi Government/Government Undertaking/ Government Autonomous Bodies/ Public Limited Companies etc.

BARC Mysuru invites Expression of Interests (EOIs) from reputed and established Chemists located in Mysuru City / Yelwal meeting the evaluation criteria as mentioned below for empanelment /short listing and issue of tender document for supplying medicines on maximum discount to CHSS beneficiaries for an initial period of one year (extendable) as per the scope of work.

- 2.0 Evaluation Criteria: Intending Chemists who submit their credentials alongwith all the details listed below shall only be considered for evaluation / shortlisting:

- 2.1 Copy of Valid license issued by Food & Drugs Administration, Karnataka. The chemist shop should be registered under Karnataka Shop & Establishment Act, a copy of which also needs to be produced
- 2.2 Copy of Goods and Services Tax Identification Number (GSTIN).
- 2.3 Copy of PAN allotted to the Chemist/owner.
- 2.4 Relevant documentary evidences of the registered retail Pharmacy Outlet within Mysuru City limits / Yelwal.
- 2.5 BARC Mysuru have two dispensaries, one each at Kuvempunagar and Yelwal. If the chemist who has quoted is not located in close proximately to any of these

dispensaries, BARC reserves the right to reject such offers and will be the sole judge. BARC reserves the right to empanel more than one chemist in the vicinity of its Dispensaries for ease of availability of medicines to its beneficiaries.

- 2.6 The chemist willing to supply medicines on home delivery basis (at no extra cost) can be empanelled irrespective of their close proximity with the dispensary.
- 2.7 The average annual financial turnover should be at least Rs.15 Lakhs during the last three consecutive financial years (FY ending 31/03/2018) certified by Chartered Accountant. Should not have incurred any loss for more than two years during the last available five years (FY ending 31/03/2018). Details shall be furnished duly supported by figures in balance sheet/profit and loss account for the last Five (5) years duly certified by Chartered Accountant.
- 2.8 Details regarding structure and organization of the firm shall be submitted.
- 2.9 Details regarding manpower possessed shall be furnished along with Pharmacist license numbers.
- 2.10 Details of authorised dealership certificates of Major Pharma companies to be attached.
- 2.11 A copy of the Registration/Certificate of incorporation of the firm is to be attached.

### 3.0 SCOPE OF WORK

- 3.1. The empanelled chemist/s will supply the medicines / drugs at the agreed uniform rate of discount on MRP (inclusive of all taxes) and on credit basis to CHSS beneficiaries immediately based on the prescription slip- issued by Medical Officers of BARC, Mysuru.
- 3.2. The chemist will be empanelled based on maximum discount on MRP offered. The selection of chemist for empanelment will be done who will offer maximum discount on MRP .The chemists will be given the counter offer at par with one who gives maximum discount and if they agree they can also be empanelled . The chemists thus empanelled will not be allowed to give medicine to the CHSS beneficiaries on MRP.
- 3.3.BARC Mysuru will provide to the qualified bidder the details of the Pharmaceutical companies and medicines (with Brand names) that are in current use. The successful bidder has to invariably supply medicines as per the above details.

3.4. In rare cases of medicine(s) prescribed by doctors is/ are unavailable with the chemist, BARC medical officer has to be contacted for issue of substitute medicine.

3.5. The empanelled Chemist will supply the medicines and obtain the signature of the CHSS beneficiary on reverse of the prescription slips and/or invoices/bills as a token of having received the medicine.

3.6. The Chemist will be fully responsible for giving any wrong/un-prescribed medicine. The bill referred there to will not be reimbursable and contract will be cancelled forthwith immediately.

3.7.. The Chemist must always keep a reasonable quantity of medicines to ensure uninterrupted supply of the prescribed medicines.

3.8. The Chemist should supply medicines required as per the prescribed quantity only, payment will be restricted as per quantity /numbers of medicines prescribed prescription slip by the Doctor.

3.9. Medicines with long shelf life(expiry date) shall only be supplied.

#### 4.0 Payment Procedure

- 4.1 Computerized bills shall be prepared ( in triplicate) item wise indicating the details of medicines issued along with prescription slip on monthly basis.
- 4.2 The firm shall submit invoice duly signed and stamped indicating Work Order No., Name of Work, PAN No., GST No. etc.
- 4.3 The Chemist shall prepare item wise report on daily basis in separate sheets & submit along with the monthly bills.
- 4.4 The Chemist shall not be eligible to claim any interest on account of delay in receiving any payment.
- 4.5 If any overpayment is detected in respect of any medicine supplied by the Chemist or alleged to have been supplied by the Chemist under the Contract, it shall be recovered by the Department from the Chemist.
- 4.6 If any underpayment is discovered, the amount shall be duly paid to the Chemist by the Department.
- 4.7 80% Advance payment will be released after receipt of bill to Chemist through ECS after submitting ECS details in prescribed format. Final payment will be


released after the end of every month based on the verification of Prescription of the Doctor & Medicine supplied based on the documentary proof jointly signed by the Chemist & Medical Officer of the concerned Dispensary.

## 5.0 General conditions:

- 5.1 Intending bidders meeting the above mentioned eligibility criteria may submit their credentials along with copies of all the relevant documents as a proof for meeting with the eligibility criteria mentioned under clause 2.0 above addressed to The Chief Engineer BARC, Mysore.
- 5.2 The bidders shall submit in person or by post the above documents in a sealed Cover duly super scribing on the cover the tender number, and name of the work. The last date for submission is 01/03/2019 upto 15.00 hrs. Any offers received beyond 15.00 hrs. either in person or by post will be treated as LATE OFFER and will not be considered for evaluation. BARC Mysuru will not be responsible for any postal delay.
- 5.3 If any information furnished by the applicant is found incorrect at a later stage, they shall be liable to be debarred from tendering / taking up work in BARC, Mysuru. The Department reserves the right to verify the particulars furnished by the Applicant independently and reject any application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of pre-qualified bidders to any number deemed suitable in case too many applications are received satisfying the basic eligibility criteria.  
Short-listing of the agencies shall be subject to thorough verification of their credentials and inspection of their premises, through a Technical Evaluation Committee of experts, constituted by the Chief Engineer, BARC, Mysuru.
- 5.4 The shortlisted tenderer's will be issued with the Tender document on payment of the prescribed fees. They shall be required to place the **Earnest Money** and the **Tender Part-I (Technical Bid)** and **Part-II (Price Bid)** in separate sealed envelopes marked '**Earnest Money**', '**Part-I**' and '**Part-II**' respectively and all these three envelopes shall then be placed in another envelope, sealed and submitted.
- 5.5 In case of successful tenderer, the tenderer is required to deposit an amount equal to 5 % [Five Percent] of the tendered and accepted value of the contract as irrevocable Performance Guarantee in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt [or] Bank Guarantee bond in the prescribed form from any of the scheduled bank [or] by Deposit at Call Receipt or demand draft or Bankers cheque from any Scheduled bank drawn in favour

of Pay & Accounts Officer, BARC, Mysuru within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of letter of intent.

5.6 In addition to the above, security deposit at the rate of 2.5 % [Two and half Percent] of the Bill value will be recovered from each bill till total security deposit amounting to 2.5% of the tendered value is recovered. Earnest Money Deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the Performance Guarantee.
