- 1.0 Chief Engineer, BARC, Mysore on behalf of the president of India , invites Sealed tenders in Two parts from the reputed , qualified ,experienced and financially sound eligible Class- I Electrical contractors who have executed “similar works” for the following works:

1.1 Eligibility Criteria : Class-I Electrical contracting firms having valid certificate issued by chief Electrical inspector to Govt .of Karnataka and those fulfilling the following criteria shall be eligible for the purchase of Tender documents.

b	Average annual financial Turnover during the last three years year ending 31 st march 2016.	Should not be less than 30 % of the estimated cost put to Tender
c	Bank solvency of a Nationalised / Schedule Bank	Not less than 40% of the Tendered value
d	Profit & Loss	Not having incurred any loss in two years or more during the last five years ending 31 st March 2016

Note : Escalation factor @7% p.a will be applied to update the cost of work executed successfully o the current level.

1.1 Similar works means having experience in industrial power distribution work involving LV systems , installation of panels & Power cables etc.

1.2 Bid evaluation Criteria : The bid will be evaluated on the basis of performance evaluation of any one of qualifying work and ongoing work at clients premises by the committee constituted by BARC, if required.

3.0 Tender documents can be had on written request on any working day from 28- 08-2017 to 08-09-2017 between 10.30 hours to 16.00 hours duly vetted by Engineer- in- Charge, from the office of Pay & Accounts officer, BARC, Postbag No.1, yelwal, Mysore- 571130. Tender will be issued only in person and will not be issued by post or courier. Prospective bidder or his authorized representative

shall bring valid photo identification like Passport, Voter's Identity Card, Driving License, Identity Card issued by the employer for entry into BARC premises for purchase of tender documents as well as their submission. Prior confirmation on phone (0821- 2406660) shall have to be taken by the bidder so as to arrange entry to BARC and review of documents.

4.0 Tender will be received up to 1500 hours on 14-09-2017 in the office of Chief Engineer BARC Mysuru and Part-I(Techno commercial offer) will be opened on 14/09/2017 at 15.05 hours in the presence of attending bidder. Price bid will be opened at a suitable later date in the presence of attending tenders .

5.0 SUBMISSION OF TENDER

Tender shall be prepared and submitted in SEPARATE SEALED COVERS IN TWO PARTS as follows:

Part I	a) First Envelope	EMD in specified format
	b) Second Envelope	Prequalification cum Technical Bid
Part II	Third Envelope	Price Bid

6.0 Part-I:Prequalification cum Technical Bid (Volumes I, II and III of the Tender Documents)

Tenderer is requested to submit Part-I under a covering letter indicating clearly details of tender, chapters, annexure/schedules of complete Tender. Total Prequalification cum Technical Bid including drawings, documents, and commercial conditions are to be included in this packet.

The tender and the earnest money shall be placed in separate sealed envelopes each marked 'tender' and 'earnest money' respectively. Both the envelopes shall be submitted together in another sealed envelope super-scribed as technical bid. The tender shall submit one original and one copy. The envelope marked 'tender' will be opened only if the Earnest Money Deposit is in order.

7 Part-II : PRICE PART (Volume IV of the Tender Documents)

Price Part should consist of only price schedule given in tender document under a covering letter and no other documents. Schedule of price shall be read with work description, relevant specifications, Notice Inviting Tender, General Conditions of Contract, Special Conditions of Contract.

Tenderer shall fill up the price figures in ink in the original Bill of Quantities of the tender documents. Tenderer shall not retype the Bill of Quantities. The rates shall be filled in figures and words. All the pages of price part (Bill of Quantities) shall be signed, stamped and dated. The tender shall submit one original and one copy.

8.0 Tender must be submitted as under:

BOTH SEALED PACKETS OF PART-I & PART-II SHALL BE SENT IN ANOTHER COVER DULY SEALED INDICATING TENDER NO, DESCRIPTION AND DUE DATE OF OPENING.

Insertion, post-script, addition and alteration shall not be recognized unless confirmed by tenderer's signature and stamp.

Incomplete tender or tenders (not submitted as per requirement as indicated in the 'Notice Inviting Tender') are likely to be rejected.

9.0 The tenders as submitted will consist of the following:

- i) Earnest Money Deposit in line with this Notice Inviting Tender.
- ii) Power of Attorney from court of Law in favour of a person signing the tender documents duly notarized in original. This will be in a stamp paper and the signature of the person shall be duly attested.
- iii) One set of tender documents duly signed on each page as a token of acceptance of all the tender terms and conditions mentioned therein, including un-priced bill of quantities and tender drawings.
- iv) Duly filled-in and stamped annexure A, B & C enclosed.
- v) Man power and tools and equipment deployment programme (category-wise and month-wise).
- vi) Any other technical information the tenderer wishes to furnish.
- vii) Latest Sales Tax / VAT Clearance Certificate along with PAN and Sales Tax / GST numbers.
- viii) Site organization chart.

Tenders prepared in any other form may be liable for rejection.

10.0 PRICE:

The Tenderer shall quote their unit rates and the total price strictly as per the Price Format of the Tender Documents.

The tenderer shall quote the prices/ unit rates both in figure and words. No material modification to the specifications, item description in schedule of items, contract clauses shall be entertained. However, any deviation and financial implications may be reflected in covering letter of tender under Part-I of tender.

In case of difference in the rates/prices mentioned in words and figures, standard CPWD norms will be followed for considering the appropriate value.

All applicable taxes & duties and other Government levies shall be included in the above price.

The estimated cost indicated in the tender is only approximate & the contractor shall work out the prices based on the BOQ.

The rates for the extra quantity should be as per clause 12 (read with para 24.3 of CPWD works manual 2014) of general conditions of contract

- 11.0 **Security Deposit** : The Security Deposit at 5% of gross amount of the bill shall be deducted from each running bill of the contractor till the sum along with sum already deposited as earnest money will amount to security deposit of 2.5% of work order value. In addition the contractor shall be required to deposit an amount equal to 5% of the tendered value of work (without limit) as performance guarantee within fifteen days as prescribed in the letter of award issued to him, this period can be further extended at the written request of the contractor to the tender accepting authority for a maximum period ranging from 1-15 days with late fee@0.1% per day of performance guarantee amount. failing which the EMD will be forfeited to the Government of India. Security deposit can also be accepted in the form of Demand draft/Fixed deposit receipts from Nationalized Banks. The Security deposit shall be valid up to the expiry of guarantee period.
- 2.0 Both part 1 and Part II will be opened in the Chief Engineers Office on the specified date & time. If desired, the contractor or his authorized representative can be present at the time of opening of tenders.
- If the date for submission of tender and opening of tender happens to be a declared holiday at a later date, the same will be postponed to the next working day.
- 13.0 It will be obligatory on the part of the tenderer to sign the tender document for all the pages/sheets.
- 14.0 It will be obligatory on all tenderers to return tender document along with drawings at the time of opening the tender whether they are making the bid or not.
- 15.0 BARC reserves the right to reject any or all tenders or to allot parts of the work to different agencies without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
- 16.0 The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of tender.
- 17.0 The right for acceptance of tender will rest with the Chief Engineer, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre who does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender and reserves to himself the authority to accept/ reject any or all of the tenders received either in part or full without assigning any reason thereof. In case of part acceptance of tender, the tenderer shall be bound to perform the

same at the rates quoted. All tenders in whom any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect, are liable to be rejected.

- 18.0 Canvassing in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
- 19.0 All rates shall be quoted on the proper form of the tender alone.
- 20.0 Tenders with any condition including conditional rebates shall be rejected. However, tenders with unconditional rebates will be acceptable.
- 21.0 The Chief Engineer on behalf of the President of India does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves to himself, the right to accept the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rates quoted.
- 22.0 The tender for the work shall not be witnessed by a contractor or contractors, who himself/themselves, has/have tendered or who may has/have tendered for the same work. Failure to observe this condition would render senders of the contractors tendering, as well as witnessing the tender, liable to summary rejection.
- 23.0 It will be obligatory on the part of the tenderer to sign the tender document for all component parts.
- 24.0 Any tenderer withdraws his tender within the validity period or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable, then without prejudice to any right or remedy, the department shall be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the Earnest Money Deposit. Further, the contractor shall not be allowed to participate in the re-tendering process of the work.
- 25.0 This Notice Inviting Tender shall form the part of the contract document.
