NOTICE INVITING TENDER

TENDER NO: BARC/TSD/ 19 /2010-11

1. Sealed Item rate tenders in two-parts in the prescribed form are hereby invited on behalf of the President of India by **Project Director (O) & Head, Technical Services Division**, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), TSD Building North Site, Trombay, Mumbai-400085 for the following work from contractors having adequate experience and capabilities to execute such magnitude of similar works and who have similar experience with different units of Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Nuclear Power Corporation of India Ltd., Public Sector Undertakings, CPWD etc.

- (i) Description : LAN and telephone cabling in Hall-1 to hall-6, CTD, REDS, AUMP, sub-stations, sheds at North Site and south site and telephone cabling at Hirup-Fiply, CISF Camp, Van-de-Graff, RCnD and A&CED building, BARC Trombay, Mumbai-85
- (ii) Estimated Cost : Rs.62,00,000/- (Sixty Two Lakhs)
- (iii) Period of completion : (12) **Twelve Calendar Months including monsoon Period.**
- (iv) Cost of Tender Document : **Rs. 1000/-** (Non-refundable) in cash or DD (preferable) of a scheduled bank issued in favour of Accounts Officer, BARC.
- (v) Earnest Money Deposit : **Rs. 1,24,000.00**

Note: Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of **Rs. 1,00,000/-** to be submitted at the time of opening of Part-A i.e. Technical Bid, issued in favour of Accounts Officer, BARC, in any of the forms viz. (a) Receipted Treasury Challan, or (b) Deposit at Call receipt/fixed deposit receipt/DD of a Scheduled Bank. Balance of **Rs.24,000/-** to be submitted at the time of opening of Part-B (Price Bid) from technically qualified tenders in the form of irrevocable Bank Guarantee, in the prescribed format from any of the Scheduled Bank, besides other form of deposit mentioned above.

2. Tender document is prepared in two parts viz. Part-A (Technical Bid) and Part-B (Price Bid). Part-A consists of the tender document that includes form for tender agreement, conditions of contract, special instructions to the tenderers, technical specifications, tender drawings etc. Part-B consists of Tender Document that gives Schedule of Quantities, list of free issue materials, etc. Submission of application for purchase of tender is from **15/07/2010 to 03/08/2010** on working days (Monday to Friday) between 10.30 hrs. and 16.00 hrs. and tender document will be sold to the eligible tenderers from **19/07/2010 to 06/08/2010**. Applications received after this dates shall not be considered for issue of tender. The application should be submitted along with:

- (a) Average annual financial turnover from project work of LAN and jelly filled telephone cabling should be at least **Rs. 18.60 Lakh** during last 5 years ending 31st March 2010. This should be duly audited by a registered Chartered Accountant.
- (b) Should not have incurred loss in more than two years during the last five years and shall not be under court receivership or under liquidation
- (c) Year-wise list of works carried out during last 5 years as well as list showing the cost of works in progress

- (d) Performance certificate in respect of completed works and reasons for delays, if any.
- (e) List of available plant & machinery.
- (f) List of technical manpower along with organizational structure.
- (g) Proof of having satisfactorily completed (based on certification of performance by client of the works) 3 (Three) similar works each of value not less than **Rs. 18.60 Lakhs** or 2 (Two) similar work each of value not less than **Rs.31 Lakhs** or 1 (one) similar work of value not less than **Rs.46.50 Lakhs**. For this purpose 'cost of work' shall means gross value of the completed work including the cost of materials supplied by the Govt. / Client, but excluding those supplied free of cost.

Similar works means ; “Supply, installation, testing and commissioning of LAN cabling and PIJF telephone cabling, telephone wiring etc.”

The tender documents (Part-A & B) can be purchased from the office of Assistant Personnel Officer, Technical Services Division, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, TSD Building North site Mumbai-400085 on any working day between 10.30 hrs. to 16.00 hrs. on payment of amount in the form mentioned above from **19/07/2010 to 06/08/2010** A pre-bid meeting will be held on **12/08/2010** at 14.00 Hrs. in the office of P.D (O) & Head, TSD at TSD Building, BARC, Trombay-400 085

3. Tenders are required to be submitted in separate sealed and super scribed envelopes containing and indicating the following:

I	First Envelope	EMD
II	Second Envelope	Part-A (Technical Bid)
III	Third Envelope	Part-B (Price Bid)

The technical bid and the financial bid should be sealed by the bidder in separate covers duly super scribed and both these sealed covers are to be put in a bigger cover which should be sealed and duly super scribed with the name of the work and due date. EMD in requisite value shall be put in separate cover and the two-part cover shall only be opened after confirming the submission of EMD in the specified form. **It will be obligatory on all tenderer to return tender document along with drawings at the time of opening the tender whether they are making the bid or not. Making of photocopies of the tender documents and drawings is prohibited.**

4. Tenders, will be received up to 15.00 hrs. on **17/08/2010** In the office of Assistant Personnel Officer, Technical Services Division, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, TSD Building Mumbai-400085(These shall not be dropped in the box at North Gate reception). Part-A (Technical Bid) will be opened on the same day at 15.30 hrs. in the presence of attending tenderer. Tenders not accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit are liable for rejection. Part-B (Price Bid) of tender will be opened at a later date to be specified and communicated to successful tenderers who are qualified through technical evaluation involving visits to the bidders' ongoing/completed work sites and holding technical discussions

5. Tenders with any condition including conditional rebate shall be rejected. However, tenders with unconditional rebate will be accepted.
6. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **(12) Twelve calendar months** (including monsoon period) to be reckoned from the **15th day** after date of written order to commence the work or from the first day of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.
7. Tender will be kept valid for **120 days** from the date of opening the tender (Part-A).
8. In case the last date of sale and/or the date of receipt and opening of tender are declared as holiday, the respective date shall be treated as postponed to the next working day.
9. Tenders are to be on the prescribed form of Bhabha Atomic Research Centre. Tenderers should quote in figures as well as in words the rates and amounts tendered by them. The amount for each item should be worked out the requisite total given. All corrections shall be attested by the dated initials of the tenderer. The tenderers not tendering for this work after purchase of tender documents must return the tender documents and drawings to the office of APO, TSD within 10 days from the due date of tender. However, the cost of tender document will not be refunded.
10. After opening of Part-A of the tender, bidders shall be evaluated for their techno commercial capability to carry out the work based on the following:-
 - a) Financial soundness and turnover during the last 5 years.
 - b) Technical capabilities in regard to tendered work.
 - c) Nature of works executed in the last 5 years.
 - d) Organizational structure.
 - e) Available resources & their deployment to carry out the tendered work.
 - f) Quality consciousness.
 - g) Adherence to time schedule for the completed works.
 - h) Tendency of the firm with respect to making extraneous claims and disputes.
 - i) Site mobilization and planning ability.
 - j) An inspection team duly constituted by **Project Director (O) & Head, Technical Services Division** may visit selected sites(s) of the tenderer.
11. The contractor whose tender is accepted will be required to furnish by way of security deposit for the due fulfillment of his contract, such sum as will amount to 5% of the contract value of work. In addition, the contractor shall be required to deposit an amount equal to 5% of the contract value of the work as performance Guarantee within 15 days after the date of issuing of letter of acceptance/work order and in any case before commencement of work. Performance Security of 5% can also be accepted in the form of Bank guarantee/Fixed deposit receipts of scheduled bank or in the form of Government Securities.

The Security Deposit will be collected by deductions @ 10% of the gross amount of the running bill of the contractors till the sum (along with the sum already deposited as Earnest Money if EMD is submitted in the form of Demand Draft) will amount to 5% of the contract value of work. The Security Deposit will also be accepted in the form of Governments Securities, Fixed Deposit Receipts of Scheduled Bank and State Bank of India. The Security Deposit shall be endorsed in favour of the Accounts Officer, BARC
12. If the successful tenderer, fails to furnish the prescribed performance guarantee on or before stipulated dates of commencement, the President of India or his successors in office shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit the said earnest money absolutely. Further, if this successful tenderer, fails to commence work within 1/8th of the stipulated time, the President of India or his successors in office shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy available in law, be at liberty to forfeit the said earnest money and the performance guarantee absolutely.

13. The acceptance of tender will rest with **Project Director (O) & Head, Technical Services Division**, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre on behalf of President of India who does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender and reserves to himself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received, without assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
14. All rates shall be quoted on the proper form of the tender alone.
15. On acceptance of the tender, the name of the accredited representatives(s) of the contractor who would be responsible for taking instructions from the Engineer-in-charge shall be communicated to the Engineer-in-charge.
16. Special care should be taken to write the rate in figures as well as in words and the amounts in figures only in such a way that interpretation is possible. The total amount should be written both in figures and in words. In case of figures, the word "Rs." should be written before the figure of rupees and word 'P' after the decimal figures e.g. Rs.1.25 p. and in case of the words the word 'Rupees' should proceed and the word 'paise' should be written at the end. Unless the rate is in whole rupees and followed by the word 'only' it should invariably be up to two decimal places. While quoting the rate in schedule of quantities the word 'only' should be written closely following the amount and it should not be written in the next line.
17. The President of India, through **Project Director (O) & Head, Technical Services Division**, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, reserves the right to accept the whole or only part of the tender and the tendered shall be bound to perform the same at the rates quoted.
18. Sales Tax or any other tax on material in respect of this contract shall be payable by the contractor and Government will not entertain any claim whatsoever in the respect. However, any change in the existing taxes and levies or new taxes and levies if introduced by the Government after the receipt of offer as well as during the currency of the contract will be duly considered and paid extra, subject to documentary proof. For this purpose the tenderer may furnish the details or taxes and levies that have been considered in the offer and rates assumed there of.
19. The tender for works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **120 days** from the date of opening of tenders (Par-A). If any tenderer withdraws his tender within the validity period or make any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall without prejudice to any right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% (Fifty Percent) of the Earnest Money absolutely.
20. The tender for the work shall not be witnessed by a contractor or contractors who himself/themselves has/have tendered for the same work. Failure to observe these conditions would render tenders of the contractors tendering as well as witnessing the tender liable to summary rejection.
21. It will be obligatory on the part of the tenderer to sign the tender document for all the component parts.
22. This Notice Inviting Tender shall form the part of the contract document.
23. The contractor shall submit a detailed list of similar works carried by them for the last 5 years including annual turn over and also works in hand (progress) in the following performa .

Please note the following:

- a) Cheque for Earnest Money Deposit will not be accepted.
- b) Solvency certificate, when asked for, should of value not less than 40% of the tender amount and should be dated not earlier than **31.03.2010** and may be submitted along with Part-A
- c) Tender forms are not transferable.
- d) Tender documents will not be sent by post or courier.
- e) Contractors will be vetted by the Security Section of BARC. Person having valid police verification certificates are only permitted to be deployed at the work site.

24. Please note that to enter BARC, photo-identity (passport, driving license, voter's I-card, I-card issue by employer, etc.) is a must. Prior confirmation of Phone No. 022-2559 5400 / 25592314 shall have to be taken by the bidder so as to arrange for an entry to BARC.

25. Canvassing in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
