NOTICE INVITING TENDER

TENDER No: BARC/MYS/PO&M/ KSD/DF-1/WO/2017/01/284

1. Sealed item rate tenders in the prescribed form are hereby invited on behalf of the President of India, by Superintending Engineer, BARC, Mysore for the following work from Contractors on approved list of CPWD other Government organizations and those having adequate experience and capabilities to execute similar works of such magnitude in Department of Atomic Energy.

- i. Description : Dismantling of process, Utility pipelines, supporting structures of decommissioned Bay/Heat Exchanger room of DF-1 and shifting of the same to DF-2 and scrap yard.
- ii. Estimated Cost : **Rs.11,80,000.00**
- iii. Period of completion : 4 (Four) months.
- iv. Cost of Tender Document : **Rs.500/-** (Non-refundable) in cash.
- v. Earnest Money Deposit : **Rs.23,600/-**

Rs. 23,600/- to be submitted along with the tender, issued in favour of Pay & Accounts Officer, BARC, Mysore, in any of the forms viz. (a) Receipted Treasury Challan, or (b) Deposit at Call receipt / fixed deposit receipt / DD of a Scheduled bank / Nationalised bank. 50% of the EMD is also acceptable in the form of a Bank guarantee valid for a period of 6 months or more from the date of submission of tender and balance 50% in any of the form mentioned above.

2. The Tender document includes scope of work, tender agreement, conditions of contract, special instruction to the tenderers, technical specifications, Schedule of Quantities, list of Free Issue Materials, etc. Sale of tender document to eligible tenderers will be **from 20/02/2017 to 30/03/2017 on all working days between 10.00 hrs to 16.00 hrs.**

An application for purchase of tender documents, in person, shall be submitted along with attested copies of:

- a. Average annual financial turnover from **similar works** should be at least Rs.3,54,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs fifty four thousand only), during last 3 years ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2016. This should be duly audited by a registered Chartered Accountant.
- b. Should not have incurred loss in more than two years during the last five years and shall not be under court receiver ship or under liquidation. Year-wise list of works carried out during last 5 years as well as list showing the cost of work in progress.

- c. Year-wise list of works carried out during last 5 years as well as list showing the cost of work in progress.
  - d. Performance certificates in respect of completed works and reasons for delays, if any.
  - e. List of available plant & machinery.
  - f. List of technical manpower along with organizational structure.
  - g. Proof of having satisfactorily completed (based on certification of performance by client of the works) 3 (Three) similar works each of value not less than **Rs.4,72,000/-** or 2 (Two) similar works each of value not less than **Rs.7,08,000** or 1 (One) similar works each of value not less than **Rs.9,44,000**. For this purpose, ‘cost of work’ shall mean gross value of the completed work including the cost of materials supplied by the Govt. / Client, but excluding those supplied free of cost.
  - h. The value of executed works shall be brought to the current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of receipt of application for tenders.
  - i. Attested copy of valid registration certificate issued by Department of Sales Tax/VAT, PAN account number.
3. Salient features of the Tender may be viewed from website [www.barc.gov.in](http://www.barc.gov.in). However interested bidders shall obtain the Tender document in person against payment of Rs. 500/- by way of cash payable to “The Pay & Accounts Officer”, BARC, Mysore on submission of relevant documentary evidence for meeting the eligibility criteria. The person deputed for buying the Tender document should have an authorization letter in the company’s letterhead and should also carry identity card issued from the company or Driving License / Passport as a proof of personal identity. The tender documents will not be sent by post or courier and should be collected personally.
  4. While purchasing the Tender document, relevant documentary evidence regarding previous works executed by the contractor shall be produced for verification, to the Engineer in Charge. The Tender document shall be sold to the Contractor only if found satisfactory of the above document by the Engineer in Charge.
  5. The Tender document can be purchased from the Pay & Accounts Officer, BARC, Mysore duly vetted by the Engineer in Charge on any working day between **10.00 hrs to 16.00 hrs on payment in the form mentioned above from 20/03/2017 to 30/03/2017.**
  6. Tenders are required to be submitted in separate sealed and super scribed envelopes containing and indicating the following.

<b>I</b>	<b>First Envelope</b>	<b>EMD</b>
<b>II</b>	<b>Second Envelope</b>	<b>Tender Document</b>

The sealed envelopes shall then be placed in another envelope sealed and submitted to the tender inviting authority. EMD in requisite value shall be put in separate cover and the tender shall only be opened after confirming the submission of EMD in the specified form. **It will be obligatory on all tenderers to return tender document along with drawings if any at the time of opening the tender whether they are making the bid or not. Making photocopies of the tender document and drawings is prohibited.**

7. Tenders can be put in the **Tender box No. 3 (Mechanical works) kept at Bldg – 2, BARC, Mysore up to 15.00 hrs on 31/03/2017.**
8. **The tender will be opened on 31/03/2017 at 15.05 hrs** in the presence of attending tenderers in the office of Pay & Accounts Officer, BARC, Mysore. Tenders not accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit are liable for rejection.
9. Tenders with any condition including conditional rebate shall be rejected.
10. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be 4 (Four) months to be reckoned from the 15<sup>th</sup> day after date of issue of work order to commence the work or from the first day of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.
11. Tender will be kept valid for 120 days from the date of opening the tender.
12. In case the last date of sale and / or the date of receipt and opening of tender is declared as holiday, the respective date shall be treated as postponed to the next working day.
13. Tenders are to be on the prescribed form of Bhabha Atomic Research Centre. Tenderers should quote in figures as well as in words the rates and amounts tendered by them. The amount for each item should be worked out and the requisite total given. All corrections shall be attested by the dated initials of the tenderers. The tenderers not tendering for this work after purchase of the tender documents must return the tender documents and drawings to the Pay & Accounts officer, BARC, Mysore within 10 days from the due date of tender. However, the cost of tender document will not be refunded.
14. After opening of the tender, bidders shall be evaluated for their techno-commercial capability to carry out the work based on the following:
  - a. Financial soundness and turnover during the last 5 years.
  - b. Technical capabilities in regard to tendered work.
  - c. Nature of works executed in the last 5 years.
  - d. Organizational structure.
  - e. Available resources & their deployment to carry out the tendered work.
  - f. Quality consciousness.
  - g. Previous experience in Precision machining components for high vacuum applications to a leak rate better than  $10^{-9}$  mbar lit/sec.
  - h. Adherence to time schedule for the completed works.
  - i. Tendency of the firm with respect to making extraneous claims and disputes.
  - j. Site mobilization and planning ability.
  - k. An inspection team duly constituted by Superintending Engineer, BARC, Mysore may visit selected sites of the tenderer.
15. **A.** The Security Deposit will be deducted @ 5% of the gross amount of the running bill of the contractor till the sum will amount to 2.5% of the contract value of work.

**B.** In addition, the contractor shall be required to deposit an amount equal to 5% of the contract value of the work as Performance Guarantee within 15 days from the date of issue of work order and in any case before commencement of work. Performance Security of 5% can also be accepted in the form of Bank guarantee / Fixed deposit receipts of Scheduled /Nationalised bank or in the form of Government Securities. If the contractor fails to furnish the performance guarantee within the period prescribed for commencement of work, the EMD furnished shall be absolutely forfeited to the President of India. The performance bank guarantee deposit shall be endorsed in favour of the Pay & Accounts Officer BARC, Mysore.

16. The acceptance of tender will rest with Superintending Engineer, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Mysore on behalf of President of India, who does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender and reserves to himself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received, without assignment of any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
17. All rates shall be quoted on the proper form of the tender alone.
18. Special care should be taken to write the rate in figures as well as in words and the amounts in figures only, in such a way that interpretation is possible. The total amount should be written both in figures and in words. In case of figures, the word “Rs.” Should be written before the figure of rupees and word “P” after the decimal figures e.g. Rs.1.25 p. and in case of the words the word ‘Rupees’ should precede and the word “Paise” should be written at the end. Unless the rate is in whole rupees and followed by the word “only” it should invariably be up to two decimal places. While quoting the rate in schedule of quantities the word “only” should be written closely following the amount and it should not be written in the next line.
19. The President of India, through Superintending Engineer, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, reserves the right to accept the whole or only part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rates quoted.
20. Sales Tax or any other tax on material in respect of this contract shall be payable by the contractor and Government will not entertain any claim whatsoever in the respect. However, any change in the existing taxes and levies or new taxes and levies if introduced by the Government after the receipt of offer as well as during the currency of the contract will be duly considered and paid extra, the subject to documentary proof. For this purpose the tenderer may furnish the details of taxes and levies that have been considered in the offer and rates assumed thereof.
21. The tender for works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 120 days from the date of opening of tenders. If any tenderer withdraws his tender within the validity period or make any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall without prejudice to any right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% (Fifty Percent) of the Earnest Money absolutely.
22. The tender for the work shall not be witnessed by a contractor or contractors who himself / themselves has / have tendered for the same work. Failure to observe these conditions would render the contractors tendering as well as witnessing the tender liable to summary rejection.

23. It will be obligatory on the part of the tenderer to sign the tender document for all the component parts.
24. This Notice Inviting Tender shall form the part of the contract document.
- 25. Please note the following:**
- a) Cheques for Earnest Money Deposit will not be accepted.
  - b) Tender forms are not transferable.
  - c) Tender documents will not be sent by Post or Courier.
  - d) Contractors will be vetted by the Security Section of BARC, Mysore.
26. Please note that to enter BARC, Mysore Photo-identity (Passport, Driving License, Voter's I-card, I-card issued by the employer, etc.) is a must. Prior confirmation on Phone 0821-2406469 & 0821-2406730 shall have to be taken by the bidder so as to arrange for an entry to BARC, Mysore.
27. Canvassing in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
28. Jurisdiction of the contract: The contract shall subject to Mysore jurisdiction only.
