The bidder should have satisfactorily completed (based on certification of performance by client of the works) 3 (Three) similar works each of value not less than Rs. 262.80 lakhs or 2 (Two) works each costing not less than Rs. 394.20 lakhs or 1 (One) similar work of value at least Rs. 525.60 lakhs during the last 7 (Seven) years ending on the last day of the month previous to the one in which the applications are invited and at least one work of any nature (either part of above works or separate one) of not less than Rs. 262.80 lakhs should have been completed in Central Government / State Government / Public Sector Undertaking of Central or State Governments / Central Autonomous bodies. The documentary proof of above shall be submitted.

Similar Works means "Miscellaneous works for Operation and Maintenance of Chemical / Radiochemical Process Plant". The similar work should have been executed in India.

- **5.** The value of executed works shall be brought to the current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7 % per annum, calculated from the date of completion to last date of sale of tenders.
- **6.** The bidding capacity of the contractor applicable should be equal to or more than the estimated cost of the work put to tender. The bidding capacity shall be worked out by the following formula:

## Bidding Capacity = $[A \times N \times 2] - B$

Where:

A = Maximum Value of similar works executed in any one year during the last five years taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.

N= Number of years prescribed for completion of work for which bids have been invited. B= Value of existing commitments and ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of work for which bids have been invited.

7. Bidder should be a registered firm in India. Joint Ventures and or Consortiums are not acceptable.

#### 8. Pre Qualifications:

- 8.1 Part 'A' Techno Commercial Cum Pre-Qualification Bids shall be opened on the stipulated date and time indicated. On opening date, the bidders can login and see the status of Bids after opening. Only those bidders who satisfy eligibility criteria shall be Evaluated.
- 8.2 After opening of Part 'A' of tender, Chief Engineer, NRG, BARC, Trombay, shall constitute an tender evaluation committee, which will visit tenderers office, selected worksites of ongoing / completed works to evaluate the capability of the tenderers based on the following.

## **Evaluation of bidders for Pre-Qualification:**

- Experience of similar works completed, bidding capacity and financial turn over etc. will first be scrutinised in detail and the bidder's initial eligibility for pre-qualification for the work shall be determined.
- A Technical Committee of experts shall be constituted by Competent Authority for evaluation of bids.
- iii. The Technical Committee will inspect the bidder's ongoing / completed work sites & offices and facilities. The bidders' eligibility related documents shall be examined and verified.
- iv. The bidders' qualifying the initial criteria as set out above will be evaluated for following criteria by scoring method on the basis of details furnished by them and the inspection report submitted by Technical Committee.

To qualify, the bidders must obtain at least **Sixty per cent** marks in each criterion and **Seventy per cent marks in aggregate**. The Department however reserves the right to verify the particulars furnished by the bidder independently and reject any bids without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable in case too many bids are received satisfying the basic Qualification criteria. The bidder qualification will be evaluated as per the marking system given below.

- **9.** As per the security procedure in force in Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, the contractors shall be vetted by the Security Section of BARC before commencement of the work.
- **10.** No modifications in the tender shall be allowed after opening of Part 'A'.
- **11.** Tenders with any condition including conditional rebate shall be rejected. However, tenders with unconditional rebate will be accepted.
- **12.** If any information furnished by the applicant is found to be incorrect at a later stage, they shall be liable to be debarred from tendering / taking up works in BARC in future forever. Also if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before start of work, the Engineer-in-charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of EMD / Performance Guarantee.
- **13.** The time allowed for carrying out the work will be reckoned from the 15<sup>th</sup> day after date of written order to commence the work or from the first day of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.
- **14.** Tender will be kept valid for 180 (One Hundred Eighty) days from the date of opening the tender (Part 'A').
- **15.** In case the last date of receipt of original document towards cost of EMD and opening of tender are declared as holiday, the respective date shall be treated as postponed to the

- next working day, correspondingly. Bidders my please be noted that no separate communication shall be made in this regard.
- 16. Original Fixed Deposit Receipt / Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque / Pay Order and Bank Guarantee, as applicable, towards Cost of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the form as stipulated in tender documents shall be deposited at North Gate to Representative of Engineer-in-charge, WMD, BARC, Trombay, Mumbai 400085 on or before the date & time mentioned above. Online bid documents shall be opened only of those bidders, whose Earnest Money Deposit placed in the sealed envelope are found in order. Consequently Part-I (technical bids) will be opened and processed further.

## 17. Cheques for Earnest Money Deposit will not be accepted.

- 18. The contractor whose tender is accepted will be required to furnish by way of Security Deposit for the fulfillment of his contract, an amount equal to 2.5% of the tendered value of the work. The Security deposit will be collected by deductions from the running bills as well as final bill of the contractor at the rates mentioned above. The Security amount will also be accepted in the shape of Government Securities. Fixed Deposit Receipt of a Scheduled Bank or State Bank of India will also be accepted for this purpose provided confirmatory advice is enclosed.
- 19. The Security Deposit @ 2.5 % of gross amount of the bill shall be deducted from each running bill as well as final bill of the contractor. Security deposits can be released against bank guarantee issued by scheduled bank on its accumulation to a minimum amount of Rs. 5 lakhs subject to the condition that amount of any bank guarantee except last one, shall not be less than Rs. 5 lakhs. The bank guarantee submitted against Security Deposit shall initially be valid up to the stipulated date of completion of the work plus maintenance period as defined under clause 17 of GCC which shall be extended further time to time depending up on extension of contract granted under provision of clause 2 and clause 5.
- 20. In addition the contractor shall be required to deposit an amount equal to 3% of the tendered value of the contract as performance guarantee in the form of DD/ FDR/ BG to be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue of work order or before commencement of work whichever is earlier. If contractor fails to furnish the prescribed performance guarantee within the prescribed period, the EMD will be absolutely forfeited to the President automatically without any notice.
- **21.** The bidder should quote for all the items as shown in the Schedule-B (financial bid). Partly quoted or incomplete bids will be rejected.
- **22.** The acceptance of tender shall rest with department which does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received, without assigning any reason. All tenders in which, any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
- **23.** Canvassing in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
- **24.** On acceptance of the tender, the name of the accredited representative(s) of the contractor who would be responsible for taking instructions from the Engineer-In-charge shall be communicated to the Engineer-In-charge.

- **25.** The department reserves the right to accept the whole or only part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rates quoted.
- 26. Your offer shall be inclusive of all taxes including GST.
- 27. GST shall mean Goods and Service tax Central, State and Inter State.
- 28. GST or any other tax applicable in respect of inputs procured by the contractor for this contract shall be payable by the Contractor and Government will not entertain any claim whatsoever in respect of the same. However, component of GST at time of supply of service (as provided in CGST Act, 2017) provided by the contract shall be varied if different from that applicable on the last date of receipt of tender including extension if any.
- **29.** Labour welfare cess @1% of gross value of work done shall be recovered from each bill paid to the contractor.
- 30. Contractor should be registered under EPF & ESIC and shall pay EPF & ESIC of contract workers to concerned Department and it will be reimbursed to him by the Department after satisfying that it has been actually and genuinely paid by the contractor. The bidder should not consider EPF & ESIC in his rates. Contractors shall comply provisions of the EPF Act, 1952 in respect of all the eligible employees / workers/ labours and submit the documentary proof regularly with every RA Bill.
- **31.** Income tax and cess as applicable shall be deducted from each bill paid to the contractor.
- **32.** If any tenderer withdraws his tender within the validity period or make any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the department, then the Government shall without prejudice to any right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50 % (Fifty Percent) of the Earnest Money absolutely. Further, the tenderer shall not be allowed to participate in the re-tendering process of the work.
- **33.** This Notice Inviting e-Tender, tender documents, construction safety manual, technical specifications and Information, Instructions for tendering posted on website, communication between department & bidders for Pre bid gueries, shall form part of the contract document.
- **34.** The Contractor shall submit a detailed list of similar works carried by them during the last 7 years ending on the last day of the month previous to the one in which the applications are invited and also works in hand (progress) and certifying that the list of works are complete and no works have been left out.
- **35.** The successful bidder whose tender is accepted will be required to obtain Police Verification Certificate (PVC) issued by Special Branch of Police at his own cost for all his workman i.e. Engineers, Supervisors & Labourer's to work in BARC Trombay and should quote accordingly. Generally, the PVC will be valid for three years from the date of issue.
- 36. In case of receipt of any adverse charter and antecedent remark / notification against the contractor / company / firm / proprietor and / or his contract personnel, consequent to the security vetting, BARC reserves absolute right to terminate the contract forthwith without assigning reason / show cause notice. The contractor will have no right to claim any losses / liability that may be incurred as consequence to the above action initiated by BARC. Department also reserves right to forfeit in part / full performance security and / or security deposit in possession of the Government for failure on the part of the contractor to abide / adhere to the security instruction issued by DAE / BARC from time to time.

## 37. Additional clause

- I. Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
- II. "Bidder" (including the term 'tender', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contexts) means any person or affirm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or officer controlled by such person, participation in a procurement process.
- III. "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means:-
- a) An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
- e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
- f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
- g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium of joint venture falls under any of the above.
- iv The beneficial owner for the purpose of (iii) above will be as under:
- 1) In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s)., who whether act5ing alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercises control through other means. Explanation;-
- a) "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more that twenty-five percent of shares or capital or profits of the company.
- b) "Control shall include the right to appoint majority of the directors or to control the management or policy decisions including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholders agreements or voting agreements;
- 2) In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership;
- 3) In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of such association or body of individuals,
- 4) Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official;
- 5) In case of trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

- V) An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings with third person.
- vi) The successful bidder shall not be allowed to subcontract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority.
- **38.
